In his thirty years in the Marine Corps, T. X. Hammes served at all levels in the operating forces to include command of a rifle company, a weapons company, intelligence battalion, an infantry battalion and the Chemical Biological Incident Response Force. He served as regimental S-2 and S-4: Division G-2, G-3 Plans, G-3 Operations, G-3 Training; MEF G-5 and G-2 Plans; and Fleet Marine Officer. He participated in stabilization operations in Somalia and Iraq as well as training insurgents in various places.

Hammes has a Masters in Historical Research and a Doctorate in Modern History from Oxford University. He is currently a Distinguished Research Fellow at the Institute for National Strategic Studies, National Defense University. He is the author of two books and over 150 articles and opinion pieces.
